Spamalot

I remember being in middle school and seeing Monty Python films and sketches for the first time and being completely besotted with them, particularly Monty Python and the Holy Grail. My friends and I ceaselessly quoted the films and sang the songs (likely to the great annoyance of others) until we graduated from high school. At college, I was readily able to identify potential new bosom buddies simply by their knowledge of Monty Python minutiae. Monty Python devotees are truly their own breed.

I was, therefore, delighted to learn a few years ago that many of the best Python bits from Holy Grail had been spackled together into a Broadway musical... truly earning its title, Spamalot. It had been years since I had seen any Monty Python whatsoever, so when I learned Milburn Stone Theatre, an organization with a history of putting on fine musicals, was going to mount this production, I knew I had to see it.

For the uninitiated, the musical itself is likely to be entertaining, albeit a bit baffling; for Monty Python fans, it will deliver in all its Python-esque glory. From the moment theatergoers enter the lobby (where they can purchase their own commemorative can of Spam), they will be immersed in all the splendor of the offbeat, absurdist brand of Monty Python humor, which even spills over into the program notes. When it comes to humor of this nature, those entrusted with it must commit to it, and MST does not fail in its charge.

The story follows King Arthur and his trusty Patsy (well-played by Mark Dixon and Steve Flickinger) along with the Knights of the Round Table, Tim Koob, Greg Guyton, Ryan Wagner, and Matt Cannon, all solid performances, on their quest for the Holy Grail. During their adventures, they encounter a colorful cast of characters: The Lady of the Lake, bombastically and thoroughly entertainingly portrayed by Lauren Spencer-Harris, and the Laker Girls, the Knights of Ni, The Black Knight, the infamous French Guards, and others, far too many to enumerate here. Though the production has many standout performances, it truly is an ensemble show, with many in the cast doubling, tripling, and even quadrupling parts throughout. Triple-threat Joe Francisco, who is making his Milburn Stone debut, is a standout, and he ably exercises all of his talents in each of his roles. It is the show's strength as an ensemble which successfully sells its many large production numbers, where Bambi Johnson's splashy, novel choreography both challenges and underscores the cast's abilities. It is truly a powerhouse ensemble.

The show runs one more weekend (8pm on Feb. 27 & 28 and 3pm on March 1), with an added 3pm matinee on February 28 courtesy of a snow cancelation on its opening weekend.

If you are a Python devotee, this show is not to be missed. If you are a friend of a Python devotee, humor her/him and just go see it anyway.
