In The Wake Of Breaks, Canal Town Needs Water Valves

For much of the winter, Chesapeake City avoided the problems of breaking water pipes.

Their luck ran out in mid-March when a north side water leaked force water to be cut to the south side of town. Bohemia Manor Middle & High School had to be closed for the day while homes and businesses were out of water for approximately 18 hours.

Town officials discussed the issue at length during a meeting this week and agreed to begin the work of making sure there are enough valves in the water lines to be able to turn off water to the least number of customers during water leaks. More than a dozen valves will be needed, but the town will start with the installation of three.

Chesapeake City will also work to better identify the location of town water pipes.

Officials discussed the need to work on the reverse 911 call system to better inform residents on water and other issues.

will begin, state officials have said.

North East Mayor Robert McKnight said the state was prompt in contacting the town with the bad news about the bridge.

"We opened a dialogue on how to handle this in the least painful way," McKnight said.

While the town has wanted to keep the bridge open during the entire bridge project, when the serious flaws in the bridge structure were uncovered, there was really only one plan of action, the Mayor said.

"We didn't have any options," McKnight said of the bridge closure.

The official detour during the MD 272 bridge closure is US 40 to Mechanics Valley Road to East Cecil Avenue.

The SHA set up a four-way stop sign at the intersection of Mechanics Valley Road and East Cecil Avenue.

The MD 272 bridge was closed on Tuesday. On Tuesday afternoon, lines of traffic were backing up on both roadways on the detour route. One town official said the four way stop signs do not allow a flow of traffic to move smoothly along the detour roadways.

Mayor McKnight said SHA personnel were gathering temporary traffic light equipment earlier this week and had promised to have traffic signals operating at the intersection before the end of this week.

"The interagency cooperation has been amazing," Mayor McKnight said.

During the shutdown of the bridge for the emergency repairs, the Mayor said the contractor will be working around the clock to get the job completed.

School buses serving the North East area schools have had to modify their routes during the bridge closure.

Cecil Transit buses have also had to change their routes because of the bridge closure. McKnight said Cecil Transit officials came to the town to discuss the needs of residents, particularly those who walk across the bridge to go to work or to visit the stores and restaurants.

The North East town hall has temporary bridge closure bus schedule brochures and people can even purchase their bus tickets at the town hall, McKnight said.

Town officials spoke of how the Senator has always gotten behind town initiatives and has been able to get funding for crucial town projects.
