second floor will be accessible to all because Tusha plans to install an elevator. The space will accommodate about 100 people.

Elk Manor is on a point of land along the Elk River. From the mansion, there are views south toward the bay and on some days, it is difficult to tell where the water ends and the sky begins. The south lawn is a popular place for outdoor wedding ceremonies. A tent set up near the mansion is a reception site that shares the view.

Tusha is planning to move the tent site and create a fantastic new tent closer to the outdoor wedding ceremony site. He is waiting for county permit approval for a 10,000 square foot, two-story tent that will showcase the water view.

The mansion is a popular setting for small events. It is often used as the staging area for brides and grooms to get ready for their special day. Gretchen Tusha took over the design of the second floor bedrooms. An area for grooms and their groomsmen is set up in two bedrooms accessible from the mansion's back staircase.

The former master bedroom at the mansion has been made over into the perfect place for brides and bridesmaids to prepare for the ceremony. The suite even includes a large screened in porch so the bride and her attendants can look out over the lawn to see the water - or check on the wedding preparations and arriving guests.

There are two other bedrooms on this floor and they, too, have received a gracious make-over.

Tusha said the mansion is often used for corporate meetings.

Another popular wedding site at Elk Manor is located next to a cottage at the riverfront. Guests
