### State Highway Administration Wants Perryville And Cecil County To Pay For A Sidewalk Along A State Roadway

A study by the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) says it is feasible to construct a sidewalk along the west side of MD 222 up to an area near the high school.

But the state does not want to fund the sidewalk along the state road.

They want town and county financial participation in the construction, right-of-way costs and other bills associated with the project.

The state also does not want to maintain the sidewalk once it is built.

Projected cost for the sidewalk project is \$323,000 plus any right-of-way acquisition costs.
