Rotary Clubs of Elkton and North East Observe World Polio Day

In honor of World Polio Day, which is widely recognized on Oct. 24, representatives of the Rotary Club of Elkton and the Rotary Club of North East will be at Milburn Orchards in Elkton from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on that date. In conjunction with Rotary's mission to eliminate the crippling childhood disease polio, the clubs will be providing resources about polio eradication as well as information on Rotary in general.

World Polio Day observance will continue at 5:30 p.m. Sept. 27, when polio survivor John Nanni speaks at the Rotary Club of Elkton meeting at Minihane's Irish Pub and Restaurant in Elkton. Nanni, a member of the MOT Rotary Club in Middletown, Delaware, has been giving polio and post-polio talks to Rotary clubs throughout the Northeast since 2010. In recognition of Nanni's presentation, the Elkton and North East clubs will be making donations to Rotary's polio eradication efforts

World Polio Day follows a succession of significant developments that have made 2015 one of the most important years in the history of the polio eradication initiative. This year, only two countries have reported polio cases caused by the wild poliovirus: Afghanistan and Pakistan. Africa has not seen a case in more than a year, and Nigeria has been declared polio-free by the World Health Organization.

Since 1985, Rotary has contributed nearly \$1.2 billion and countless volunteer hours to the protection of more than two billion children in 122 countries. Although the disease remains endemic in just two countries, other nations remain at risk for imported cases.
