County Council Wants Face-To-Face Strategic Plan Review

Cecil County Councilwoman Joyce Bowlsbey said she "wants a separate discussion" with County Executive Tari Moore so the Council can review and update the county's strategic plan. County budget officials told Bowlsbey on Tuesday that the review of the strategic plan is included in the annual budget document. Moore also sent a document to the Council on the state of the strategic plan.

Bowlsbey said a separate meeting was what the 42-member volunteer Charter Committee wanted when they drafted the document several years ago and that they owe it to the public to hold a meeting since the Charter calls for it to be held in an open session.

The Council will send a letter to the administration asking the County Exec to pick a date to meet with them.

County Exec Is Thanked For Caring

One citizen at the Town Hall meeting on budget priorities lives in the Lakeside Community near North East. He thanked County Executive Tari Moore for listing to the community association's concerns and helping them resolve some issues to help improve their neighborhood. He said Moore is the first elected official in many years to try to help Lakeside residents.
