Milburn Stone Theatre's Artistic Director Resigns



Milburn Stone Theatre at Cecil College has lost its long-time artistic director.

In a social media post, Lee Lewis announced he is leaving the local theater.

"Over the course of the last decade, it has been my sincere honor and pleasure to dedicate myself to building the Milburn Stone Theatre into the institution it has become," Lewis posted. "In that time, the college has grown tremendously and with that growth comes inevitable change."

"Unfortunately, with those changes, I now find myself in a position where my vision for the future of the theatre is no longer aligned with the prevailing winds," Lewis wrote.

"I feel as though I have no other choice but to resign as the Producing Artistic Director of the Milburn Stone Theatre," he posted. "I do so sadly, and with great fondness for the theatre and everyone who has worked so hard to make it what it has become; however, I look forward to future opportunities to continue showcasing those things about Cecil County that I have come to know and love."

When asked to comment about Lewis' departure, a college spokesman said Cecil College does not discuss personnel issues.

Formed in 1968, the theater at the college is named for the actor who played the character Doc on the popular "Gunsmoke" television show which ran from 1955 to 1975 and had 635 episodes. Actor Milburn Stone met life-long county resident and theater fan George Prettyman and became friends with him. The actor's family donated money to Cecil College's theater program and the theater was named for the popular television actor.

The mission of the Milburn Stone Theatre is "fostering and supporting excellence, education and appreciation of the arts while striving at all times to become the premier theatrical house in the region for our audience whatever their age or interests."

During Lewis' tenure as Producing Artistic Director, the popularity of the theater grew as evidenced in increases in theater ticket sales. The Milburn Stone Theatre hosts at least 20 special events each year. The current year's production schedule honors the talents of Stephen Sondheim.
