Initially, the County Council expressed the opinion that their approval is not needed for this proposed chicken farm, so they can have no input. Citizens suggested legislation including a requirement from Kent County that all of the manure from a chicken farm has to be applied to the land on the farm, effectively limiting the size of a chicken growing operation.

Members of the County Council made some comments during the Citizen's Corner and the legislative session.

"There's a lot of misinformation out there about this," said Council President Robert Hodge.

Hodge said he has been to the recently-opened Meck Farm operation, which is located along MD 213 just south of the Bohemia River. He said the chicken houses emitted very little odor and he was surprised there were no flies or mosquitoes around the structures.

The Council President said there are many steps that

the Horst family has to take before the chicken houses are approved. He asked the citizens for direction as to what type of legislation they would wish, wondering where they draw the line between an acceptable family farm and what they view as a large corporate operation.

The crowd was not pleased when Councilman Dan Schneckenburger agreed he would not want to raise children near an area with contamination, but then asked for their definition of contamination.

Schneckenburger offered to attend any meeting the citizens hold on the topic.

"We certainly heard you tonight," he said.

Council Vice President Dr. Alan McCarthy said, "I am very attuned to your concerns."

Councilwoman Joyce Bowsbey told the citizens to continue to keep them up to date on their efforts and to share any ideas they have.

"We're taking this very seriously," Hodge said. "The fact is no permits have been issued....This is not a done deal."
