improvements

-Work will continue on roundabouts at MD 273 at Appleton Road and MD 291 at Muddy Lane. The roundabout at MD 273 at Blue Ball Road will also start soon.

-Sidewalk projects are in the works for MD 267 from Bladen Street, Market Street to MD 7C

-Drainage projects in several locations will cost nearly \$3.5 million

-Trees will be planted near District 2 locations

-Other tree plantings will cost more than a half million dollars

-The state is also assisting with the visitor center at the old Jacob Tome Gas House in Port Deposit

This week, the Cecil County Council discussed the upcoming meeting with the state. The Council is also concerned about the MARC maintenance facility near Perryville. The issue has been discussed for the past three years and the state is still working on the property acquisition.
