## Voting Process Is Secure

over a private network, Towery said.

The paper ballots that are fed into the machine are also safely maintained, she said.

"The paper ballots themselves are under lock and key," Towery said.

Prior to each election, the Election Board conducts training sessions for the approximately 300 people who handle the Early Voting polling place and the 19 precincts open on Election Day. Both new and returning election judges have to attend three hours of instruction to make sure they understand the process and any changes that the legislature have made the to voting process, Towery said.

During the time leading up to Early Voting and the General Election, the Board of Election office is a very busy place.

"The stress level is pretty high," Towery said. "There's so many things happening at once."

The office fields dozens of phone calls from voters who want to know where they have to go to vote and other information. Absentee ballot requests come in and have to be handled. There is trouble shooting at the polling places, she said.

For voters, the election process ends when they cast their votes and hear the results after the polls closed on November 8.

"It's not over for us on election day," Towery said.

The election office has audits and other details to complete. By November 18, they will submit the report to Governor Larry Hogan that certifies the vote in Cecil County.

"Then we have a lot of other paperwork that we still have to process," Towery said.
