We feel so lucky that the PTSO offered this opportunity. There has been difficulty in some schools with students leaving orchestra because they are unable to transport their cello to and from school. This is putting us on a path to make sure that never happens at NEMS. Three students are already dependent on this wonderful gift!" said Myers. "We just can't say thank you enough!

Not only did the PTSO purchase a cello for the school but the Tech Ed department received a 3D printer via the essay written by student Cody Russell. Mr. Joseph Olski, the schools tech ed instructor, also received a free training course and starter materials, from Printed Solid in Newark, Delaware with the group's purchase of the printer. Students have already started to use the machine and it has been a great tool in teaching technology to this generation of kids.
