county government board on the school board

Cecil County Executive Alan McCarthy said he, too, was unaware of the delegation's bill until after it was introduced in late January.

"I didn't know anything about it," Dr. McCarthy said.

The County Council reviewed

a report that compared the Cecil County Board of Education salaries with the salaries of other education boards throughout the state of Maryland. The list also compares the sizes of each jurisdiction.

For instance, Cecil County board of ed members are paid \$3,500 and the board President receives \$4,000

to manage the educational system in a county with a population of 101,108. Neighboring Harford County has a population of 244,826 and pays school board members \$3,600 and the board president also receives \$3,600. Wicomico County, which has a population similar to Cecil County, pays their school board members \$3,700 and board president \$4,000. Montgomery County school board members make the most at \$25,000, with \$29,000 for the school board president. In Baltimore City, the board of education serves without any paycheck.

As of press times the Cecil Guardian did not receive information from Delegate Kevin Hornberger.

Sewer Plant Flows Are Questioned

Looking at the figures for effluent in both the north side and south side sewer plants, Chesapeake City officials decided they need a closer look at the issue. They noted that flows jumped by nearly 200,000 gallons comparing one month with the same month last year on the north side, while they declined by 300,000 gallons in the same comparison period on the south side.
