CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTIONS**

On April 4, 2017, the Mayor and Council of Port Deposit adopted three Charter Amendment Resolutions as follows:

Resolution 12-2017. This resolution amends Article VI, Section 610 Conduct of Elections to insert a new (d) The Board of Supervisors of Elections shall cancel the election and certify a candidate duly elected in the event that a lawfully nominated candidate for Mayor or Councilmember is running for office unopposed. If the Election for one office is cancelled under this provision, the remainder of the ballot, if applicable, shall not be affected and the election for any office remaining on the ballot shall not be cancelled.;

Resolution 13-2017. This resolution amends Article V, Section 501 b (10), General Powers to eliminate enlightenment and insert enlightenment; and

Resolution 14-2017. This resolution amends Article XIII, Section 1307 Seperability (sic) to eliminate Seperability and insert Severability.

These amendments shall become effective and part of the Town's Charter on May 25, 2017 unless a petition to have any one or more of such amendments submitted for referendum vote signed by 20% of the qualified voter of the town is presented to the Council on or before this date.
