to their home and there were two previous claims from the property. Their home was constructed close to the ground and they realized that with the plumbing and electrical lines in their crawl space, even a slight rise in water around their house could cause a lot of damage and inconvenience. Flood waters rising above their floor joists would do considerable damage to their living space.

The Braleys decided to go for the grant program.

The application process was not easy and involved a lot of paperwork.

"That was 2014 and we've been working on it ever since," Heide said. "There's a bunch of agencies you have to go through - MDE (Maryland Department of the Environment), state, federal."

The couple has also had to coordinate with local contractors. A final meeting will be held on Friday. On Monday, the house movers will be preparing the house for the lift.

"They expect it to take about ten days before they are actually ready to lift," she said.

Several steel beams will be

placed under the Braley house. A housemoving company, Wolfe House Movers, from Pennsylvania will oversee the lifting of the house.

"They do massive projects," Heide said.

The project to lift the 1,700 square foot Braley home will take about two weeks. The house will be lifted up approximately eight feet off the ground. This will place the home three feet above the expected five foot maximum expected flood level for the Braley property.

"The base flood elevation is so high in the town," Heidi said.

The grant will cover the cost of lifting the structure.

Eric Braley, who is also a North East town commissioner, said the long process to obtain the grant and the disruption to his home and property during the home lifting process is well worth it.

"We love it here, the birds, the fish, the property," Eric said.
