## Cecil College Celebrates - PTA Graduates With Ceremony

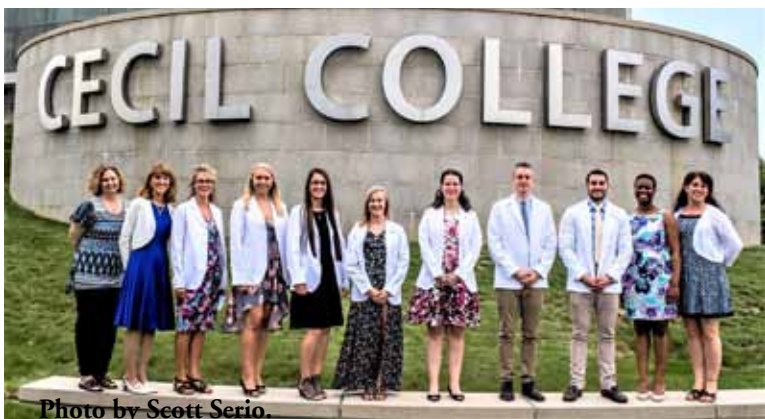

In honor of its second cohort of physical therapist assistant graduates, Cecil College held a white coat and pinning ceremony to recognize the achievements of Karen Simmons, Ashley Hejl, Emily Dean, Samantha Laubach, Amy Schwartz, Christopher Lutes and Antonio Posada.

The white coat and pinning ceremony celebrates the transition from student to clinician or from the classroom to the arena of clinical care. During the ceremony, each student is presented with a white coat, the symbol for clinical care and service by a practicing physical therapist. The coat is pinned with a lapel pin with the emblem for a physical therapist assistant as designated by the American Physical Therapy Association. The pin signifies the new professionals as being welcomed into the larger global community of physical therapists and physical therapist assistants. After receiving

their white coats and pins, the students recite the Physical Therapy Oath committing themselves to integrity, excellence, compassion, altruism, respect, empathy and service in the practice of physical therapy.

In addition to their classes and time in the lab, all students in Cecil's PTA program apply their learnings and receive hands-on training by completing three clinicals, totaling 600 hours, including an inpatient experience, an outpatient experience and a third experience. The college has clinical agreements with more than 30 facilities in Maryland, Delaware and Pennsylvania.

The next step for Cecil's graduates is to take the National Physical Therapy Exam on July 6. All of the students in the first cohort passed the exam, which allowed them to begin their careers as physical therapist assistants, on their first try and quickly found jobs in the field.
