Commercial Recycling Haulers.

W.L. Gore & Associates was the #1 Recycling Business. It was the 9th time they took this honor. In 2016, W.L. Gore recycled 4.5 million pounds of material.

The award ceremony recognized Chesapeake Ridge Apartments. Their recycling efforts earned the #1 Recycling Apartment Building or Condominium award.

Tanya Adams, Recycling Program Manager in the county, thanked the award winners for their hard work operating serious recycling programs. She noted that it several of the categories were quite competitive.

Adams was recognized by the Cecil County Council for her efforts to encourage recycling in the county.

This was the 12th year that Cecil County government has recognized municipalities, private firms and other organizations for excellence in recycling and waster reduction.

administration also noted that the new fee puts the county more in line with neighboring jurisdictions.

The County Council voted on the fee cut during their evening legislative meeting. Earlier in the day, they reviewed a policy document from the Department of Public Works that explains the regulations for people to attach to county sewer lines when they are installed.

DPW Director Scott Flanigan explained that with the planned Elkton West sewer line extension and plans to run sewer lines to the Holloway Beach area, the public needs to understand the county’s stance on sewer service.

Flanigan said there are two reasons for sewer lines to be extended into areas. The primary reason is to serve an area where the septic systems have become unhealthy for residents and pose a threat to the environment. Other reasons to expand sewer service include economic development.

In the Holloway Beach area, there are health and safety reasons for public sewer service and everyone will have to immediately tie into the public sewers.

For the Elkton West expansion, the county policy encourages people to tie into the system, but allows them to wait up to ten years to join the public utility.

Flanigan said the county will “call each one (resident) and ask if they want to defer.”

If they say they want to tie-into the system immediately, Flanigan said there is an advantage because that connection will become part of the project.

Prior to expanding sewer services, the county is required to hold a public meeting. The one for Elkton West will be held in the early fall, Flanigan said.

County Councilman Bob Meffley observed that the informational document on the county’s policies should also include the positive aspects of public sewage for the homeowners, including a higher property value and the ability to add onto a home or possibly build more structures on the property.

Snatcher’s Creekside Obtains Liquor License

The Cecil County liquor board granted a Class B - beer, wine and liquor license to a North East business.

Lynn Bollinger hopes to open Snatchers Creekside at 510 S. Main Street sometime in September.

The location was formerly operated under the

name Paradise Grill.

Bollinger, whose family once owned the Howard House in Elkton, said the menu at Snatcher’s Grill will be limited to start.

They will be open until 9 p.m. Sunday’s through Thursdays and until 11 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays.
