A public hearing will be held by the County Council of Cecil County on Tuesday October 3, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the Elk Room of the County Administration Building, 200 Chesapeake Blvd, Elkton, MD on the following:

**Bill No. 2017-17 Budget Appropriation and Budget Transfer - Board of Education Capital Project - Gilpin Manor Elementary School Replacement Project.** A Bill to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, in order to provide an additional appropriation of \$78,698.23 in revenue and expenditure authority within the General Fund for the consideration received for property from the Town of Elkton; and amends the Board of Education's Capital Project's Fund revenue and expenditure authority by \$78,698.23 in order to transfer the consideration to Cecil County Public Schools for the payment of permit fees for the Gilpin Manor Elementary School Replacement Project.

**Bill No. 2017-18 County Council - Procurement - Exemption - Publication of Notices and Codification of Laws.** A Bill to amend the Code of Cecil County in order to exempt the legal notices and codification of the Code from procurement procedures.

**Resolution No. 45-2017 Approval- Transfer of Real Property - Town of Rising Sun - Rails to Trails.** A Resolution to approve the transfer of real property located within the Town of Rising Sun for use by the Town as part of its Rails to Trails Program.

**Resolution No. 46-2017 Approval- Abandonment and Sale - Hayes Lane.** A Resolution to approve the abandonment of a "paper" road called Hayes Lane, which is located in the Fifth Election District, Cecil County, Maryland, and an agreement to sell Hayes Lane to Eric Polansky and Charmie Polansky, and to PLLH, LLC, for consideration totaling Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

said it is not reasonable to expect a park to generate enough money to pay for its creation and on-going maintenance, adding that he is happy that the revenue from tournaments and field rental help pay for some of the costs of maintaining the facilities.

"I would like to see the establishment of more recreational facilities for our residents," McCarthy said, noting how parks provide walking trails, kiddie equipment and other amenities to help keep people fit at all stages of their lives.

"This will be here for generations," McCarthy said of the current park investments.

School Superintendent Devine said that the Harford County

schools where Cecil County athletes go to play games all have artificial turf fields and have had them for years, so local students have been far behind other students in the state when it comes to sports facilities.

Perryville Mayor Jim Eberhardt came to the press conference and added that the pride that the Perryville High School students and the community can have in the new field at the school is valuable for the entire community.

Dr. Devine added that the partnership is also an example of the great relationship between the school system and the county and she looks forward to additional partnerships.
