Looking to prove his doctor wrong, he enrolled at Cecil and graduated.

A few years ago, Swan received an email from Sam, which said, "When no one else believed in me, you all believed in me, and I want you to know when I transferred from Cecil College I went on and earned my bachelor's degree. Now my goal is to teach."

The event also included the annual presentation of the McIlwain-Shoty Stethoscope Fund awards to nursing students. This fund was established when longtime supporters Cynthia McIlwain and Forrest McIlwain joined forces with Michael Szep and Chris Ann Szep, Cecil College vice president of community and government relations and college advancement, to ensure the college's nursing students have high quality stethoscopes to advance their learning experiences.
