Maryland's existing outdoor recreation businesses.

The commission will be co-chaired by the Secretary of Natural Resources Mark Belton and the Secretary of the Department of Commerce Mike Gill and be comprised of 17 members appointed by the co-chairs with the approval of the Governor. Members will include representatives of companies within Maryland's outdoor recreational manufacturing and retail industry, representative of companies representing small business outdoor or heritage recreation service providers, nonprofit organizations, representatives of gateway cities, towns or communities and legislative members.

The commission will be meeting for the next two years. Their final report is due on the Governor's desk by December 1, 2019.
