For the lawn, he did not use sod. He prefers to use grass seed, saying it takes more time and care to use seeds, but he said he prefers the results with a seeded lawn.

While planting any dirt yard with grass is challenging, Blanca said this was not their biggest lawn challenge. She said getting grass to grow in the sandy soil of their New Jersey home took a lot of work to improve the soil so grass could thrive.
