course of her forty-two year career, Dr. Devine has remained a teacher at heart," stated Dawn Branch, President of the Board of Education of Cecil County. "Even for those who worked with her or for her, we have all learned so much from Dr. Devine as she has been the model of professionalism, work ethic, and dedication to one's profession. Most of

all, Dr. Devine has shown an unwavering passion and commitment to public education and the students of Cecil County." Dr. Devine has been an education leader across the State of Maryland and is currently serving as President of the Public School Superintendents Association of Maryland. She has held leadership positions in the Eastern Shore of Maryland Education Consortium, the Maryland Negotiation Service, and served as Co-Chair of the State Board's Committee on Discipline. She was appointed to the P-20 Education Leadership Council by the Governor in 2014 where she continues to serve. Dr. Devine was named 2018 Maryland Superintendent of the Year in October and was recently also awarded the 2017 Maryland School Safety Superintendent of the Year Award by the Maryland Center for School Safety. In 2014, she received the Athena Women in Leadership Award. The Board of Education will begin plans to conduct a search for the next Superintendent of Schools following their official vote on Dr. Devine's retirement at their January meeting
