NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
STRATEGIC HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN**

The Cecil County Department of Public Works, in conjunction with the Cecil County Sheriff's Office, will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, March 20, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Elk Room of the Cecil County Administration Building, 200 Chesapeake Blvd, Elkton, Maryland for the purpose of soliciting public input regarding the County's Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) which is currently being developed.

A cross-functional group of representatives from state, county, and municipal law enforcement, public works, and other agencies; local fire companies; and other interested stakeholders is in the early stages of developing the Cecil County SHSP. The purpose of the SHSP is to identify actions that can be taken to reduce the frequency and severity of motor vehicle crashes, including those involving bicyclists and pedestrians, which occur on roadways in Cecil County.

The purpose of the public meeting on March 20th is to receive public input to assist in developing the plan. The public meeting will run from 6:00 – 6:50pm that evening; the County Council will conduct a legislative meeting in the Elk Room beginning at 7:00pm. At the SHSP public meeting, members of the SHSP Committee will provide an overview of the SHSP development process and will then open the meeting up to receive public comment. In order to afford everyone who wishes to comment an opportunity to do so, speakers will be limited to three minutes each.

The SHSP Committee is interested in hearing suggestions from the public regarding things that can be done to reduce motor vehicle crashes and/or particular areas of concern.

Persons wishing to provide input but who are not able to attend the public meeting may do so in writing via e-mail to mklacka@ccgov.org or letter addressed to Director of Public Works, Cecil County Administration Building, 200 Chesapeake Blvd, Suite 2400, Elkton, Maryland 21921. For best consideration, such written input should be received by 5:00pm, Friday, March 30, 2018.
