A public hearing will be held by the Cecil County Council on Tuesday, May 22, 2018 at 7:00p.m. at the ELKTON HIGH SCHOOL AUDITORIUM, 110 James Street, Elkton, MD 21921 on the following:

Bill No. 2018-02 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance – FY 2019. A Bill to adopt the County Budget including the Current Expense Budget, Capital Budget, Special Purpose Budgets and Grants Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, and to appropriate funds for all expenditures for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018.

Bill No. 2018-03 Capital Improvement Plan – FY 2019-2023. A Bill to approve the Capital Improvement Program for Cecil County for Fiscal Years 2019 through 2023.

Bill No. 2018-04 Lease and Purchase – Vehicle and Equipment Financing. A Bill authorizing and empowering Cecil County, Maryland to enter into new financing under a lease purchase agreement or similar arrangement in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) for Fiscal Year 2019 for the purpose of financing the acquisition of certain necessary and essential vehicles and equipment for use in the County's governmental programs; providing that the obligations of the County under the agreement shall not be a general obligation of the County, shall not constitute a pledge of the full faith and credit or the taxing power of the County and shall not constitute a debt of the County within the meaning of any statutory or constitutional provision, but shall be subject to appropriation in each and every fiscal year during the term of the agreement; empowering the County Executive to execute and deliver an executive order prior to the execution and delivery of the agreement in order to award the agreement to the successful bidder and to fix, prescribe and determine the details of such financing; and relating generally to such financing.

Resolution No. 19-2018 Fees - Mosquito Control Spraying. A Resolution to establish fees for mosquito control (spraying) pursuant to Md. Code Ann., § 5-404, Agriculture Article and Cecil County Charter § 508.

Resolution No. 20-2018 Fees – Wastewater Rates. A resolution to establish fees and rates for the Cecil County Wastewater system.

Resolution No. 21-2018 Adoption of Property Tax Rate – FY 2019. A Resolution to levy and impose a property tax for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019; setting the tax rates for property and providing for the collection of property tax. Real property is fixed at \$1.0414 on each \$100 of assessed valuation of such property; personal property and operating real property is fixed at 2.6035, and Winding Brook Special Taxing District property tax is levied at the rate of 286.52 per parcel.

This contract is for a project to construct approximately 540 LF of 8" and 2,620 LF of 12" gravity sewer piping with all appurtenances as shown on the Contract Drawings and described in the Specifications. The work here in includes but is not limited to installation of sewer, manhole (s) sanitary house connections up to the right of way line, a jack and bore across Route 40 of a 24" steel sleeve and paving restoration and maintenance of traffic.
