Thomas Wilson

"I want to be the voice of the taxpayers," Wilson said.

In the fight against drug abuse, Wilson said the county needs tougher policing, opportunities for drug treatment, education and jobs. He explained that people need goals, such as good jobs, to look forward to in order to keep them away from drugs.

While he has not delved in the county's budget in detail, Wilson said it is important to stop any wasteful spending and to even bring some private sector concepts, such as incentives, to encourage government workers to spend less money.

"We really need to look at the priorities here," he said, spending on education. Wilson home-schooled his children and said he wants to see competition for the public schools.

District Four, Two Candidates

Ed Larsen

Larsen said he wants to help Cecil County grow wisely and thinks he can use his business skills to help in Cecil County government.

"I want to be your advocate," he said.

"I want to do what it takes to hold the line on taxes," Larsen said, explaining that county government has to prioritize spending and look for efficiencies. For instance, he said the county could move the animal control operation to a more central location in the county.

Larsen said tougher law enforcement is needed to fight drugs. "We have to stop the flow," he said.

Larsen, who home-schooled his own children, said he thinks enough money is already being spent on education.

George Patchell

"I believe Cecil County's best days are ahead," Patchell said, summing up his run for another term in office. He said he wants to help make sure Cecil County is set for the future and that youngsters growing up here can stay here and find work.

In the area of business development, Patchell said the county needs to make sure developers have buildings ready to accept new business. The county's role is to make sure infrastructure is in place.

As for the drug addiction issue, Patchell said, "You are not going to arrest your way out of this problem." he suggests the multi-pronged approach of education, rehabilitation and law enforcement. He supports the county's lawsuit against the opioid manufacturers.

"I believe we have a very strong public school system," he said.

"I consider myself a community activist," Patchell said, explaining that his goal is to work to make his community and the county better. Patchell supports education and will continue to make sure government does not waste taxpayer money.
